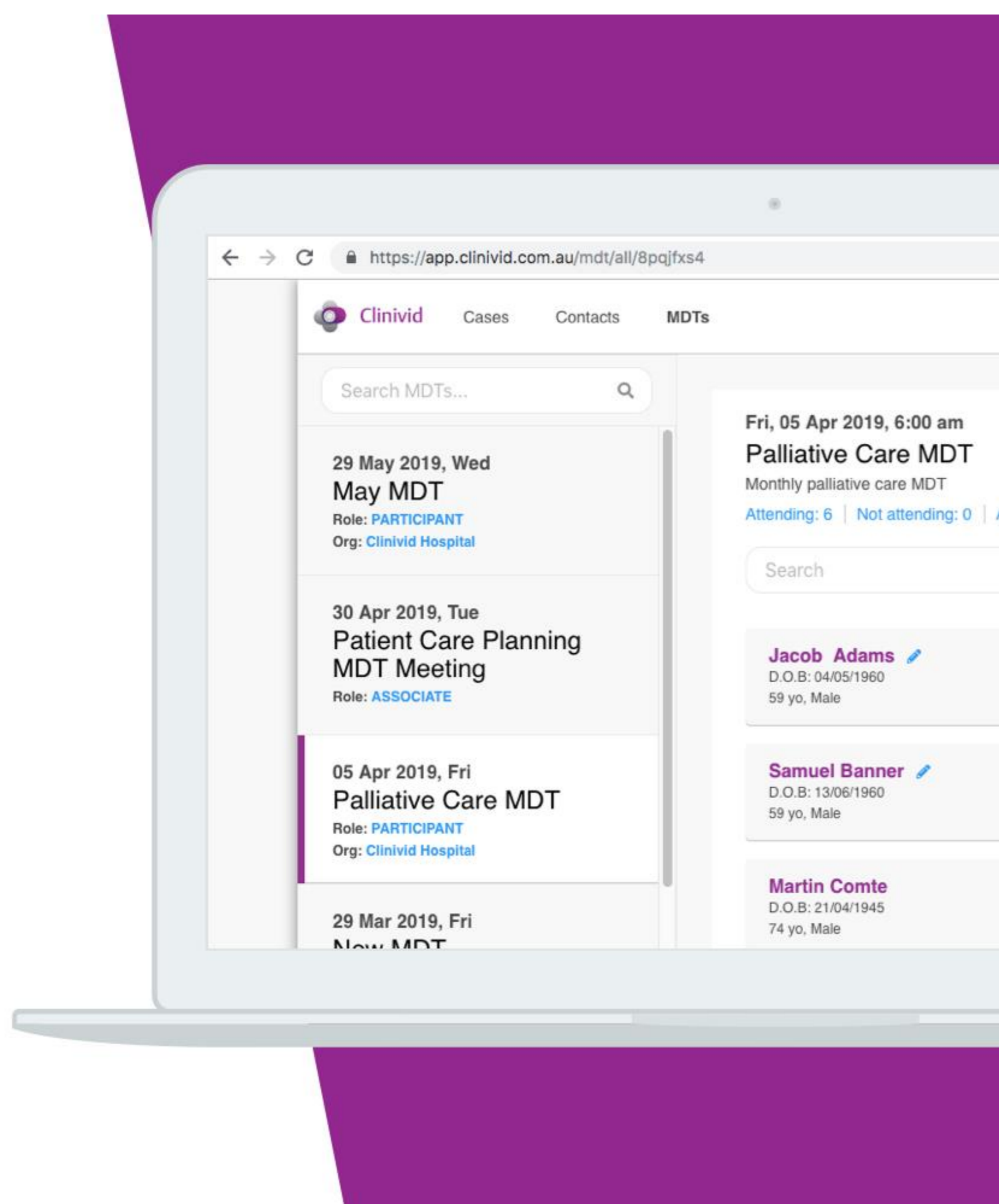

Background

Patients with cancer | chronic diseases require complex, multidisciplinary care.

Face-to-face meetings are difficult to organise, particularly in a remote setting.

Challenges to increase due to ageing population.

Solution

- works on-site and virtual
- adapts to existing clinical workflows
- shares results with the whole care team instantly.

Future

- Work with meeting coordinators and clinicians to incorporate feedback.
- Adapt for discharge and chronic disease management*.
